Dear Sirs:

This letter is to draw your attention to a subject which we have discussed before with the council and with the councillors individually.

The question is this. Is there any way to stop the electrical inspector of this municipality from doing the underhand work which he has done against us for the last few years?

The inspector, knowing that a construction permit has been taken out at a certain place, goes there and convasses the electrical work in favor of Mr. Hutchison, who is an electrical contractor in this district. He tells the people that Mr. Hutchison does electrical work at a lower price than any other licensed contractor in this municipality.

I believe this to be an injustice which we contractors have to

submit to without being able to control it, because this work is being done in an underhand way, and gets to the ear of people doing construction work. Personally, I am sure I have lost several thousand dollars of work during the last few years through these tactics.

Five years ago I started my business in this municipality, basing it on the quality of the work with a reasonable price. It is proved by looking at our trucks and by listening to our ad on the radio that our work is always guaranteed.

I have succeeded in hiring six men. (I do not believe that the inspector can say that much for himself) this also proving that our

customers are satisfied with our work.

The G. Electric, no matter whether in Vancouver, Burnaby, New Westminster, Port Moddy, Cloverdale, Port Coquitlam or Haney has never disgraced the Municipality of Coquitlam.

I want you to be sure that I will not allow a man as incompetant in business and in the electrical trade, to destroy the business I

have built up during the last five years.

Last Thursday Mr. Ball from Austin Road came to the shop to ask us to do a wiring job for him. Several minutes before I went to see the job, the inspector was there and advised Mr. Ball's son to see Mr. Hutchison about his wiring because he pave the lowest estimate in this municipality.

This is not the first time this has happened. Several people have already told me that they had been advised to take Mr. Hutchison by the inspector who is supposed to be an authority on electrical matters.

Gentlemen, I am hoping that you will give this question your fullest attention, because I would like to see this settled in the council without forcing me to put this into the hands of higher authorities on the subject.
