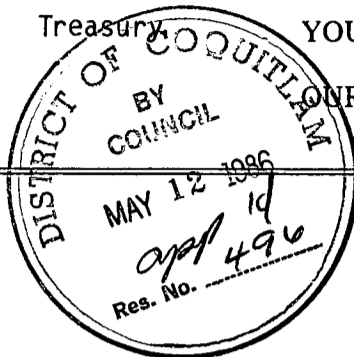

Following the swearing in of the members of the 1986 Court of Revision, Mr. Dong explained the basis of imposing local improvement charges and responded to questions from the members present regarding same.

Mr. Dong advised the Court that 342 notices have been mailed and that no complaints against the 1986 Local Improvement Roll had been received. Mr. Dong advised the Court that the District would not be requesting additional changes to the roll and it would therefore be in order to confirm and authenticate the Local Improvement Assessment Roll.


