



- 1) Encourages, assists and promotes the development of cultural activity.
- 2) Acts as a resource and clearing house for cultural information.
- 3) Acts as a liaison with the Cultural Services Branch of the Provincial Government so that grant monies can be made available, through the Council, to community arts groups and artists.
- 4) Provides ⁹ Arts Scholarships annually to each Sr. Secondary School in the disciplines of drama, music and visual arts.
- 5) Working with all levels of government to build and Arts Centre for District #43.

A variety of cultural events are sponsored by the Council--concerts, craft fairs, visual art exhibits, classes, a multidiscipline arts festival and a social dance. As well, the Council participates in District #43 community festivals.

The Council is operated by a yearly, membership-elected Executive Board. Its' work is carried out on a volunteer basis by its' members. It is supported financially my memberships, grants and fundraising activities.

A newsletter is sent to all members at various times throughout the year reporting on a multitude of arts happenings. An A.G.M. is held each Sept. and general meetings are held throughout the year.



Our member groups represent clay work, doll collecting, fibre work, graphics, heritage preservation, painting, photography, professional classical performance, theatre and vocal performance.

Our individual members represent any of the above disciplines as well as those who believe that the Arts are an important part of everyday living.
