ITEM I

MINUTES

505-1 - Approval of Minutes

Minutes of Meeting of Heritage Square Liaison Committee January 12, 1998 were approved.

ITEM II

BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

505-2 - Phase 3 Project Status

A. Tender Update

Tenders were received on March 30, 1998 and the lowest tender was more than 30% over available budget. Project scope was reduced and architect was instructed to revise documents for re-tendering. Revised tenders received on July 24, 1998 were analyzed and contract is now awarded to the lowest bidder, K Edgar King.

B. Budget Update

The total revised budget for phase 3 is \$760,000 which includes construction of 7 parking spaces from phase 4 to under link in this phase.

C. Schedule Update

Construction on phase 3 is to commence this week and anticipated to be substantially completed by January, 30, 1999

D. Other Grant

Grant Application submitted to Heritage Trust for restoration of Ryan House. To date we have not received any confirmation from them. It was discussed that the City will review the financial benefits prior to accepting this grant, as it may force the City to comply with Provincial Fair Wage Act.

ITEM III OTHER BUSINESS

505-3. Phase 4 Project Status

A. Infrastructure Grant - Phase 3 & 4

Federal/ Provincial Infrastructure Grant in the amount of \$378,896. is approved for phase 3 and 4.

B. Project Scope

Architect has been instructed to proceed with design of phase 4 in accordance with the approved program and available project budget of phase 4.

C. Funding and Budget Analysis

Memo from Ken Wright to City Manager for contract award of Phase 3 and including project funding and budget analysis was distributed.

D. Schedule Analysis

Phase 4 documents are being prepared for tendering in October, commence construction in November and substantial completion by 30 March, 1999.

505 - 4. Air Conditioning for Ryan House

Gillian stated that after the revised scope, phase 3 is a bare bone project, with basement to be finished in future by Place des Arts. She expressed concern that currently the Ryan House has no provision for air conditioning, and requested that required rough-ins be included now for cost efficiencies to allow future installation of equipment.

Project Coordinator estimated \$7,000. to \$8,000. for this work and stated it can be added to the contract by September end without any significant impact on the schedule.

City Manager instructed Project Coordinator to work out details for inclusion of roughins only for future air conditioning.

505 - 5. Moving of Caboose

Proposed location of Caboose on the site is acceptable to Railroad Association. Doug will get cost estimates for moving and confirm funding amount Railroad Association has for Caboose relocation.

ITEM IV ADJOURNMENT

The Committee thanked Ken Wright for his efforts and cooperation on this project and wished him success in his new job with the Water Works Department in Victoria.

505-2 - Development Permit Progress

505-3 - Phase 3, Drawing Status

A. Working Drawing Progress

Ken stated that consultants are working on the contract documents now.

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B. Budget

It was stated that bids must be received to confirm the exact budget. Revisions to drawings or budget could only be analyzed after bid close.

C. Schedule

Completion of working drawing may be delayed by couple of weeks. Schedule will have to be updated after Rand Iredale is back from his holidays. A prequalification ad for general contractor is anticipated in the next week or two.

505-4 - Phase 4 Design Progress

Additional on-site parking study sketches not received from the architect. No further progress on Phase 4 design.

Vraj to obtain application forms and criteria for grant application to B.C.21 and Heritage Trust. B.C. 21 grant application could be for new link construction and Heritage Trust application for restoration of Ryan House.
