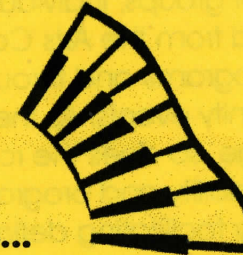

A Historical Resource



The Community Arts Council of Coquitlam, Port Moody, Port Coquitlam, Anmore and Belcarra was first established in 1969 as the *Coquitlam Area Fine Arts Council*. It was renamed the ARC Arts Council in 1992 to reflect the Council's role as an Arts Resource Centre working to promote arts and cultural activities that fulfill the needs of the communities constituting School District 43.

Funding is provided by the Government of British Columbia, municipal grants, fundraising, memberships and donations.

As a registered charitable non-profit organization, the work of the Arts Council is performed by its members on a volunteer basis through a Board of Directors and managed by an Executive Director.

Over ARC's 30 year history member groups, individuals and local governments have benefitted from the Arts Council's involvement in developing new programs and through the sponsorships of numerous community events. As the communities cultural needs change, so does the role of the Arts Council. We have assisted in facility and program development and are now actively facilitating defined cultural policy for the region.

Membership in ARC is mutually beneficial and will ensure our partnership continues to provide this community with a clear and strong cultural voice well into the 21st century.
