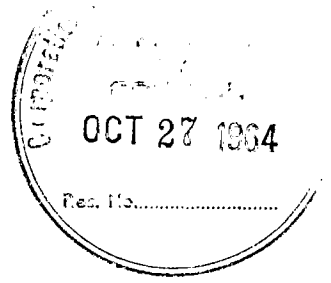

GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE

A Meeting of the Grievance Committee was held in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Hall, 1111 Brunette Avenue, New Westminster, B. C., on Thursday, October 15th, 1964, at 10:00 a. m., with Co. Vallance in the Chair, Co. Gamache, Municipal Clerk and representatives of the Union present.

It was reported that Mr. Cross, Mr. Jackson, Mr. Bruneau, Mr. LeClerc and Mr. Morneau are employed by the Sports Centre as permanent staff and Section 5 & 4(b) of the Agreement requiring 10¢ per hour for permanent night shift, has not been paid.

Moved by Co. Vallance seconded by Co. Gamache:

That this appears to be in order and that it should be paid, but that in the future permanent staff in the Sports Centre enlarging the number of five, be referred to the Council and Bargaining Committee enclosing advertisement or posting used in such cases.

Carried.

It was discussed in detail the question of seniority along with rates should be studied and considered in the 1965 Agreement. The Committee were informed that a letter from the Union will be forthcoming asking to open the Contract, January 1st.

A report on sick pay taken by employees, if possible, will be compiled showing the past three years experience.

Moved by Co. Gamache seconded by Mr. Proctor:

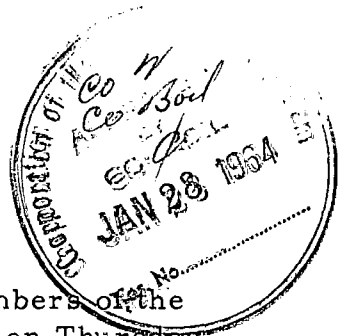
That the meeting adjourn.

The meeting was called to order and a letter of December 24th, 1963, from Mr. J. Sadler, Director of Welfare, was read.

Mr. Blanchard's report was studied and found very difficult to understand as it dealt with the operation of the Provincial Services District of Coquitlam Welfare Office and the City of Port Moody and Port Coquitlam with view to mergering.

That the matter of amalgamation of these services be held over until Co. Vallance meets with Mr. J. Sadler and Mr. Blanchard on Tuesday, January 21st, 1964.
